LTD-15 is the 15<sup>th</sup> International Workshop on Low Temperature Detectors, a biannual conference series that provides an international forum for discussing the latest research, ongoing development efforts and applications of cryogenic detectors for radiation and particles. The rapid technical developments of the last years and their outstanding features make these detectors very attractive in a variety of fields ranging from fundamental research to applied science.

Approximately 250 physicists and engineers will attend LTD-15. Conference participants represent more than 100 top-level universities and research institutes worldwide. Research areas covered include astronomy and astrophysics, dark matter, nuclear and particle physics, X-ray materials analysis, thin films, semiconductor and superconductor applications, ion spectroscopy and bio-molecule mass spectrometry. Technologies commonly used by LTD-15 researchers include cryogenics, cryo-electronics, thin-film deposition, nano- and micro-fabrication, data acquisition and analysis, etc.

#### Insurance Requirements:

- I. (a) EXHIBITOR must provide and keep in force throughout the duration of this Agreement, at its own expense, Comprehensive General Liability insurance with primary minimum limits of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) on a per occurrence basis, and two million dollars (\$2,000,000) Excess per occurrence, for bodily injury and property damage to protect against any liability arising out of the EXHIBITOR's use of the Caltech Facilities or resulting from any accidents occurring in or about Caltech's premises as a result of the EXHIBITOR's use of the Facilities. The "California Institute of Technology and its trustees, officers, employees, agents and volunteers" shall be endorsed on the policy/ies as additional insureds, and such coverage shall be on a primary basis, non-contributory with any other insurance coverages and/or self–insurance carried by Caltech. The endorsement shall contain a Waiver of Subrogation waiving any right of recovery the insurance may have against Caltech.
- (b) If the business conducted by the EXHIBITOR under this Agreement necessitates the use of vehicles, the EXHIBITOR must provide automobile liability insurance with limits of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) each accident for bodily injury and property damage arising out of any one accident covering all owned, hired, non-owned and employee non-owned vehicles and where applicable, Personal Injury Protection. (c) EXHIBITOR shall provide Workers' Compensation (Statutory) and Employers Liability insurance with limits of one million dollars (\$1,000,000). EXHIBITOR agrees that EXHIBITOR'S employees or agents are acting strictly as representatives and/or personnel of the EXHIBITOR at all times while at Caltech. EXHIBITOR certifies its compliance with all applicable Workers Compensation laws, and provides Workers' Compensation Insurance for all persons employed by it in the premises covered by the Agreement or in connection with the business conducted pursuant to this Agreement. The endorsement shall contain a Waiver of Subrogation waiving any right of recovery the insurance may have against Caltech.

EXHIBITOR will furnish certificate(s) of insurance evidencing the coverage described herein from 5 (a) through (c) above to the Caltech Risk Manager thirty (30) days prior to commencement of Agreement. If the certificate(s) is not received by Caltech by the stated deadline, Caltech reserves the right to cancel the Agreement immediately. The policies shall include provisions that the policies and/or endorsements may not be cancelled or modified to limits below those stated above without thirty (30) days' written notice to Caltech. The EXHIBITOR's insurance carriers must be admitted and licensed to conduct business in the State of California and must have an A. M. Best rating of no less than A-VIII.

- 2. Indemnification. EXHIBITOR shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless Caltech, its trustees, officers, employees, students, and agents from all claims, demands, suits, investigations or other such proceedings which arise as a result of or are related to this Agreement ("Claims"), and any losses, damages, costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees and costs, and liabilities arising out of such Claims ("Losses"), including Claims and/or Losses arising from or related to:
- (a) the use of the Caltech Facilities, Caltech property, equipment, materials or other resources by the EXHIBITOR,
- (b) infringement of any patent, copyright, or other intellectual property arising out of any acts required to carry out this Agreement,
- (c) personal injury, death or property damage related to or caused by any products or services provided by Caltech hereunder, or any products or services provided by the EXHIBITOR, including those incorporating any resources provided by Caltech hereunder or any information or know-how provided pursuant to this Agreement, and
- (d) from data, prototypes, product(s) expertise or training offered by Caltech pursuant to this Agreement, in each case except to the extent caused by Caltech's gross negligence or willful misconduct.

Caltech shall promptly notify the EXHIBITOR of any claim for which it seeks indemnification hereunder, provided that any delay in providing such notice will not relieve the EXHIBITOR of its obligations hereunder. The EXHIBITOR shall have the right to control the defense and settlement of such claim, provided that the EXHIBITOR may not enter into any settlement which admits guilt, culpability or liability on the part of Caltech or any of the indemnified persons without Caltech's prior written consent. Caltech shall have the right to participate in the defense of any such claim with its own independent counsel at its own expense.
